


OUR STRATEGY

PLAYERS, ROSTERS & TEAMS

As young players, they progress at different rates. We entrust our coaching staff with overseeing the player evaluation process and players chosen for teams in their respective age programs. This means that they may be given the opportunity to play with different players and different teams in the division. They will also be given the opportunity to be coached by different coaches in the division throughout the season.
